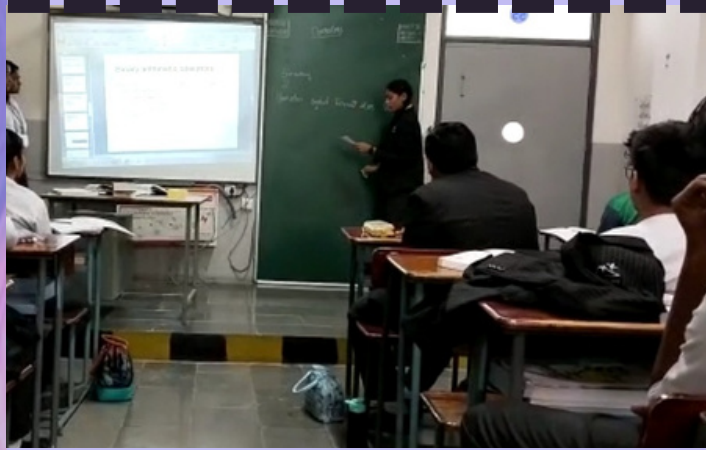
CISCE Regional (AP & Telangana) Badminton Championship (under-19)

TEAM BUILDING

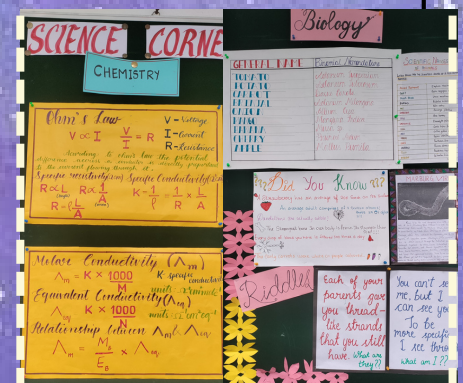

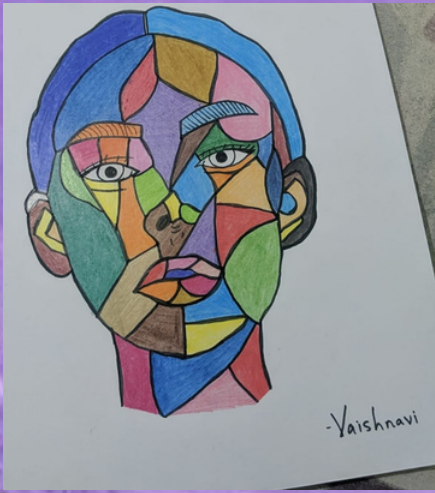
